The Academic Council, P.B. College Gauripur has been formulated as part of decentralization of administration to maintain a congenial academic atmosphere and to keep pace with the changing needs of the academic development. The Academic Council P.B. College, Gauripur bridges the academic transaction between affiliating university and P.B. College, Gauripur.

Aims and Objectives:

- To take decisions for effective curriculum planning and delivery through well planned documented process.
- To work with cells and units for conducting continuous internal assessment.
- To maintain healthy academic environment in the college.
- To promote students friendly relations and cooperation with college authority, members of teaching staff, non-teaching staff and students community.

Formation:

As per the decision of the Governing Body of P.B. College, Gauripur, the Academic Council P.B. College shall be formed with the Principal as the Chairperson and the Academic-in-Charge as the Convener. All the HoDs of the teaching departments shall be the members of the council. The Coordinator IQAC, Coordonator, Examination Cell, and Coordinator RUSA shall also be the members of the Academic Council, P.B. College, Gauripur. However, the President of the Governing Body may nominate any teaching member as required in the council.

Terms of the Office:

The term of the office of the Academic council shall be three years and it will be reconstituted by the Principal of the college subject to the approval of the Governing Body. The President of the Governing Body may dissolve the Council with the decision of its meeting.

Powers and Functions:

The Academic Council, P.B. College, Gauripur shall -

- Prepare Academic Calendar and Central Routine of the college at the beginning of Academic year ensuring effective delivery.
- Monitor and evaluate the academic progress with IQAC in terms of timely completion of course and commencement of internal examinations.
- Coordinate with the Principal in implementing the academic regulations of the affiliating university with regard to various courses of study.
- Determine the intake capacity of various courses of study in both BA and B.Com Programmes.
- Recommend add on and value added courses designed by the teaching departments of the college.
- Co-operate Examination Cell in ensuring the CIE and monitoring the activities of various cells and units of the college with IQAC.
- Assist IQAC in analyzing Feedback collected from different stake holders of the college and provide recommendation to the management.

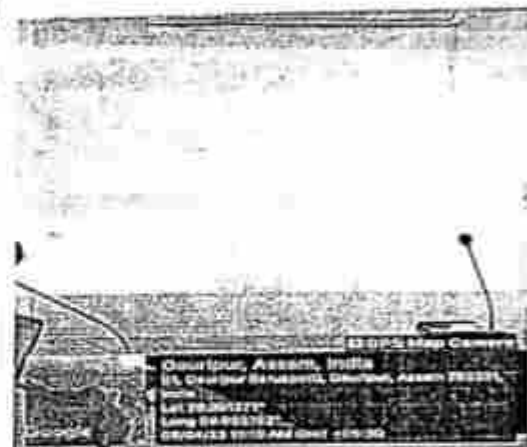

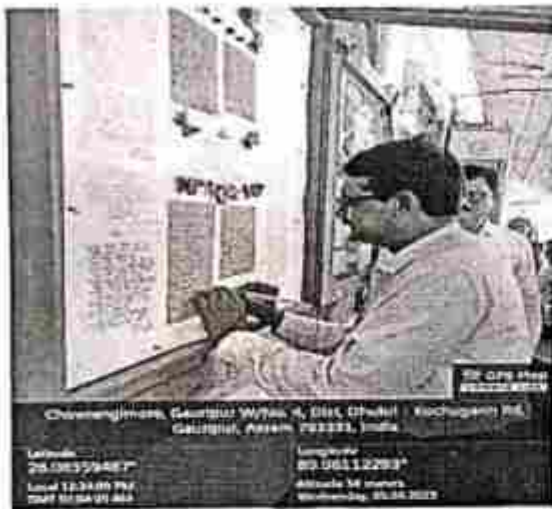
