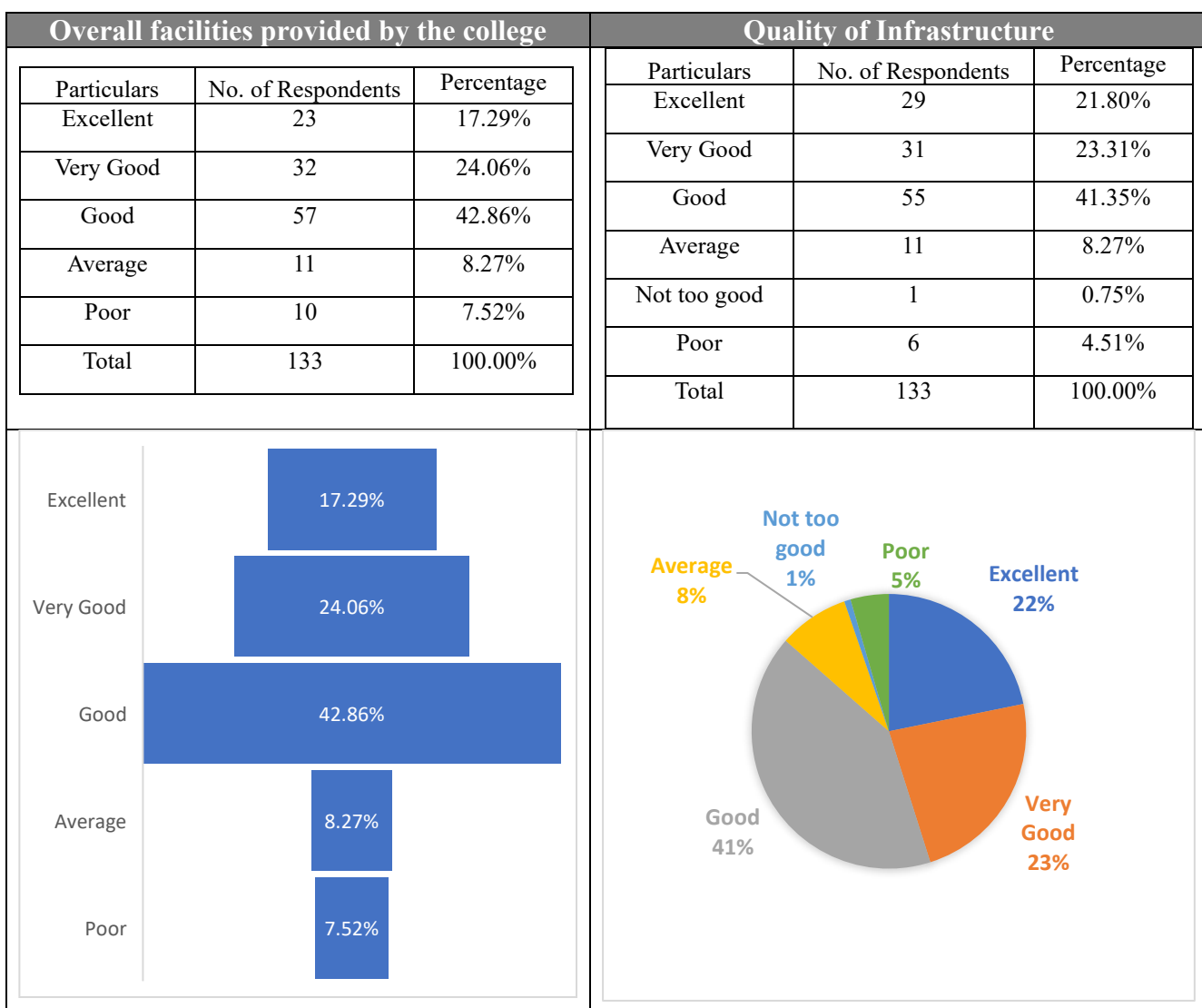






Report on Parents'/Guardians' Feedback Session 2024-25

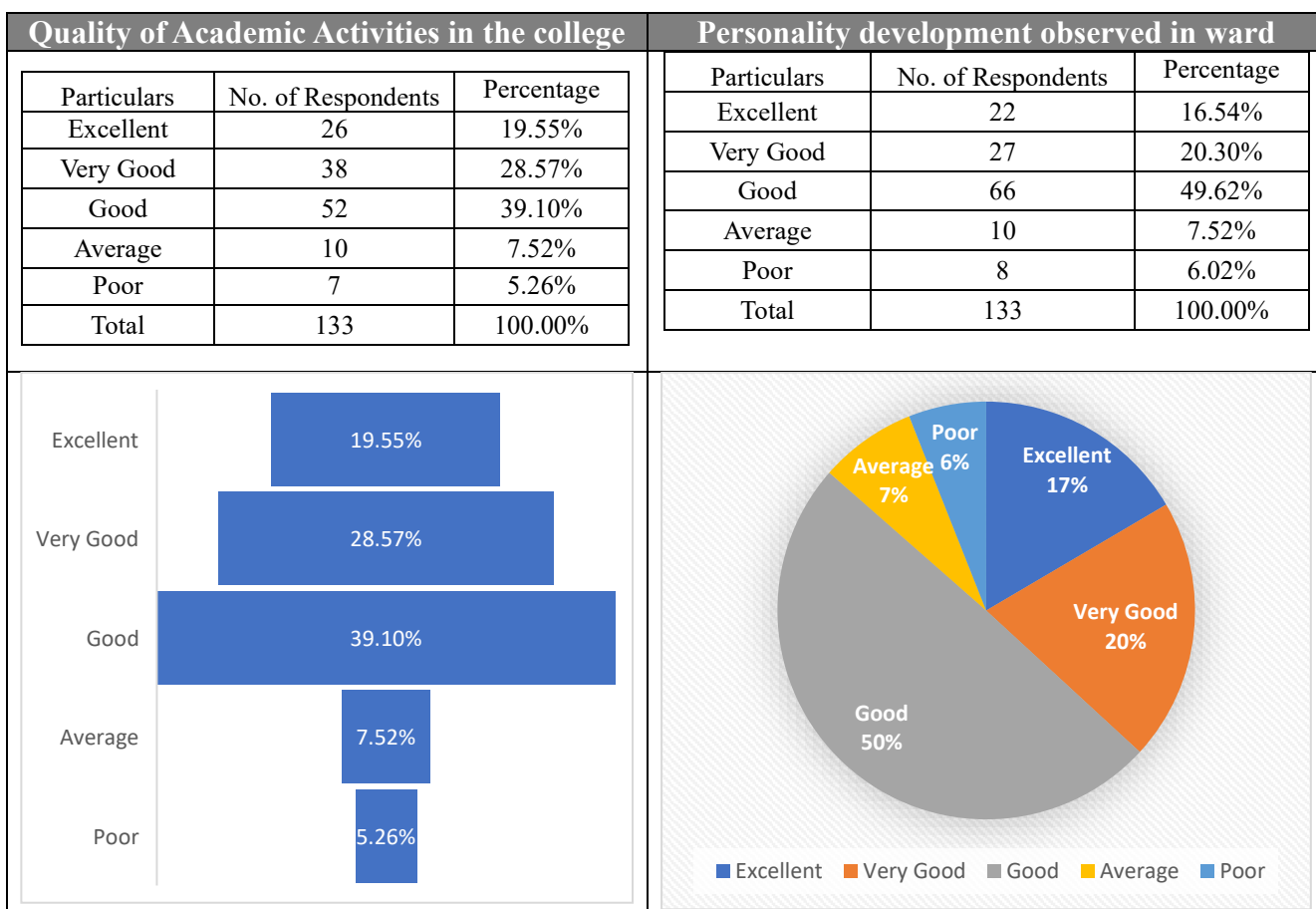

Comments: The feedback indicates that a majority of parents/guardians rated the college's facilities and infrastructure as *good to very good*, reflecting general satisfaction with the physical and academic environment of the institution. However, a small percentage of respondents rated the facilities as *average* or *poor*, suggesting the need for periodic maintenance and upgradation of infrastructure. The responses also highlight satisfaction with the library facilities and grievance redressal system, though continuous improvement in accessibility and responsiveness could further enhance stakeholder confidence. Safety and security measures on campus were largely rated as satisfactory, while feedback on hostel facilities suggests moderate satisfaction with scope for improvement in living conditions and amenities.

Comments: The responses show that parents and guardians generally perceive the quality of academic activities and overall student development as *good to very good*, reflecting the institution's effectiveness in delivering quality education. Most respondents agreed that the college contributes positively to the moral and ethical development of students and provides ample opportunities for co-curricular engagement. However, the feedback on the *job orientation* of the syllabus and *academic improvement ratings* indicates that some parents expect more industry-relevant and skill-based learning experiences. Strengthening academic mentoring, enhancing employability-focused initiatives, and introducing value-added programs could address these expectations more effectively.

**Common observations/
suggestions for improvement:**

- *Organising frequent skill- based workshops and counselling sessions;*
- *Washroom and drinking water facilities to be improved;*
- *Library facilities should be upgraded;*
- *Increasing the number of smart classrooms and classes aided with modern technologies;*
- *Provision of more extra-curricular opportunities for students*
