The Women Cell of the college organized an awareness programme on cancer on 17th October, 2019 in the digital classroom of the college. Mrs. Jayantimala Chokraborty and Sri. Dipak Chakraborty, former professor in IIT Mumbai, was the resource person. Parvin Sultana, Assistant Professor, department of Political Science introduced the guest and greeted them with a phulam gamocha. The programme typically aimed to educate the female students about cancer, its prevention, early detection, treatment options, and support services available. The noted speaker Jayantimala Chokraborty focused on specific types of cancer, such as breast cancer particularly in case of women, and their impact on individuals. She enlightened that breast cancer affects both men and women, although it is more prevalent in women. She shared that cancer causes when cells in the breast grow out of control and form a tumor.
